



## Limehouse Landing

Charleston, South Carolina

### PROJECT SUMMARY

Charleston County Parks and Recreation Commission installed a single Pontoon Floating Dock and boat ramp in 2008. They continued their effort to provide boating and fishing access to the people of Charleston by once again choosing GatorDock on the Limehouse Boat Ramp. The second phase included an additional Pontoon floating dock as well as a fishing pier. The floating option allowed the docks to always be at the appropriate height regardless of water level or tide fluctuations. Both ground out docks were fitted with an aluminum cage to protect the dock from the concrete ramp. GatorDock's non-skid aluminum decking provided a safe, high-traffic option for the public recreation area. The Parks and Recreation Commission's new docks and pier will be a maintenance free solution for many decades to come.
