PROJECT SUMMARY

Live Oak Landing was a much anticipated boat ramp site for the residents of Baldwin County. At the end of 2013, the site was selected to be the host of Alabama's Bass Trails southern division tournament. ATM, the engineering firm on the project, chose GatorDock to build the four dock, three lane boat launch site. The end docks were cleverly designed in "L" shapes to provide additional areas for passenger and package loading and unloading. This efficient design came in handy at the beginning of March for the large bass tournament by allowing more boats to launch and load. Gator worked with the county and engineers to build and deliver this large dock system in just 60 days.
