

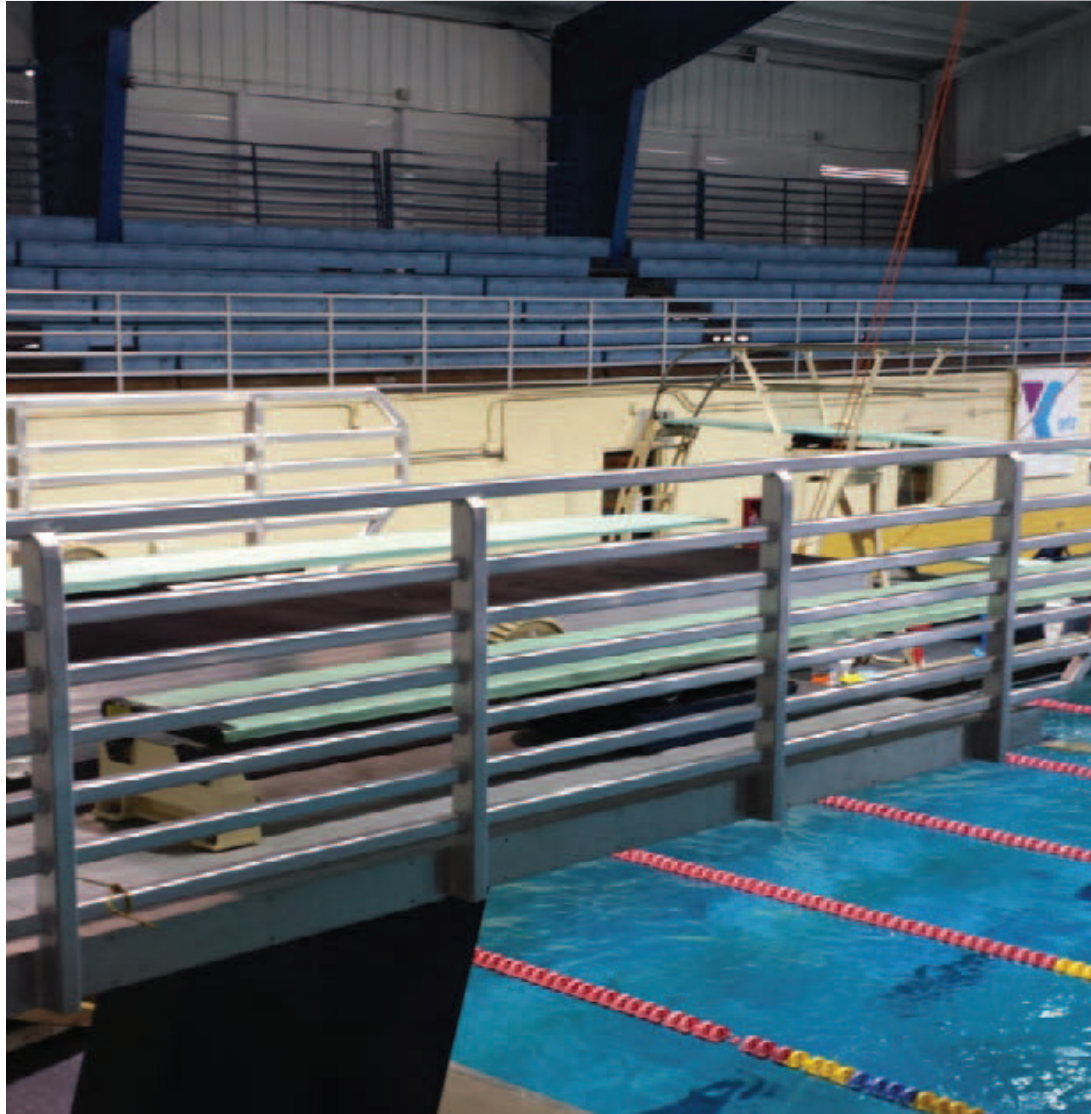


Olympic Training Platforms

PROJECT SUMMARY

This famous lodging and sporting center was opened in 1985. The original steel and stainless steel platforms were in poor condition due to thirty years of corrosion. Gator's design engineers worked with the contractor to create a custom solution that provided aluminum catwalks, stairs, and ladders as well as improved diving platforms. The updated 3, 5, 7 and 10 meter platforms now provide past and future Olympians rust-free, safe training equipment. Future renovation plans include replacing rusted stainless steel handrail with Gator aluminum railing in the spectator sections.
