PROJECT SUMMARY

East Coast waterfronts are traditionally designed with wood. However, marine products made of wood have a very short lifespan and constantly need to be maintained. Hometown America, a private marina developer/owner, wanted a durable, longlasting product that would stand up to the corrosive salt water environment. GatorDock met all the requirements for this project while being cost effective. Our marine grade aluminum frames were decked on site with pressure treated wood and matching fenders were installed. Hometown America combined the durability and long life of GatorDocks™ with the wood aesthetic to create a classic New England marina.
