PROJECT SUMMARY

Gator Fishing Piers have become famous for their innovative rail design. The slanted resting rails offer fisherman of all heights comfort while the bait shelf provides an elevated space for tackle boxes or fish cleaning. The aluminum pier requires minimal maintenance and remains cool to the touch even in the strong sun. St. Marks National Wildlife Refuge wanted a long-lasting, ADA compliant pier that would not harm the protected waters and wildlife. Unlike treated wood and steel, this aluminum pier will not leach toxins into the marsh. Lastly, the aluminum pier design required less than half the number of pilings than a similar wood pier would require which saved money and minimized the environmental impact during installation.
